12/6 arrival of the guests

On **13th June**, Archil, Madli and myself (Dutt) met Dr. Mosad and his colleague in TalTech. We discussed various outstanding issues (including financial concerns). We all conceded that project activities were generally affected for the last two years due to the Corona pandemic. However, notwithstanding our differences, we resolved to work together more intensively in the near future. Dr. Mosad requested us to send him the pending work sheets (if any) so that he can expedite any due payments.

On **14th June**, Madli, myself (DUTT) Dr. Mosad and his colleague met with Hanno Tomberg of the Open University. We had a long and fruitful discussion. We resolved that if the ICU project gets an extension from the European Commission then, next year in **February, 2023**, Hanno will provide a special intensive open university session for ISM4 (Thorough integrated eHealth system and visions into the future of healthcare) in Tallinn for 1 week. We expect 25-30 participants from Egypt/Lebanon to visit TalTech for this open university session. This will be a Train-the Trainer event with hybrid classroom sessions.

In the meantime, in **September, 2022**, Madli and myself will arrange for an intensive Train-the-Trainer session (with hybrid classroom sessions) in TalTech for 1 week.

We expect 20-25 participants from Egypt/Lebanon. The main focus will be on:

1. Smart city and eHealth (Ralf Martin Soe and team)
2. Medical devices and biomedicine (Mart Minn and team)
3. Medical law (Pawan and co-lecturers)

Madli will work out further details and forward them to Dr. Mosad in this regard. Dr. Mosad will identify possible participants from Egypt/Lebanon and send us their details so that the visa process can commence.

In **October, 2022**, we are also exploring the possibility to have a visit to Egypt and Lebanon partner universities with some TalTech guest speakers. The exact topics will be finalised shortly.

Dr. Mosad also met Professor Tanel Kerikmae briefly and exchanged pleasantries.

We thanked Dr. Mosad for his visit to TalTech and hoped to intensify project cooperation (for ICU and ICARE projects) in the coming months.
